1. Select button labeled Montana School Library Shared Digital Collection.
2. Use drop down menu and select Helena High School.
3. Click on message to sign in. Use the following credentials:

4. Browse for ebooks and audiobooks using Collections or Subjects or search for specific titles or authors using the Search bar located on the top right of screen.
5. Once an ebook or audiobook is checked out, read or listen from your browser or download to your kindle app.
