Next Week Meal Order links

Please remember to pre-order meals for your student(s) for next week by next Monday at 9am. Use the links below. Each link is designed for a specific time frame and you will have access to new links starting every Thursday for the following week. You will need to place an order for: in person class days for either the AA or the BB schedule, and you will need to do a separate order for the other 3 days of distance learning. If your student is distance learning all 5 days a week you will need to put in only 1 order weekly.

There is a lot of data involved in this multi-platform education program, so we are asking that all meals be ordered through this system so we can be sure to feed your students in a timely and efficient manner without the problems of waste or not having enough food.

This weekly email will have links in it, but you will be able to access the same links each week on the school district website under the School Lunch Program as well.

Distance learning meals will all be distributed on Wednesdays for the following 5 school days. It does not matter if you have only 3 or the full 5 distance learning days, they will all be handed out through the 8 locations on the order form during the same time. If you have more than one student you will need to put in order for each child, but you can pick them all up at the same location at the same time.

For in school days breakfast will be "grab and go" on the way to the classroom, and all lunches will be brought to their classroom just before lunch. This goes for all education levels k-12.

Please remember that meal prices are in effect for whatever approved F/R/P status you have been approved for. These meals are not free unless you are approved for free or your student attends a CEP school (Bryant or Central). Each meal will be processed through every student's individual account. If a negative balance is incurred each family will be responsible for payment.

All meals meet or exceed the USDA nutritional requirements and come with fresh/canned fruit and vegetables through a rotation schedule as well as fresh local milk that you can choose either: 1% Chocolate or white in 1% or skim. Every meal is made in a controlled and safe environment that will eliminate cross contamination and the spread of viruses and pathogens.

We do recommend that you apply for "Free" meals especially in these times if not there are the prices for meals:

Breakfast at all levels - Paid \$1.45 or Reduced \$.30

Elementary Lunch \$2.75 or Reduced \$.40

Secondary Lunch \$2.85 or Reduced \$.40

Milk for in school only \$.50
