2. Please read the following requirements for the class and return the application with your signature and parent signature with your registration form. Your registration will not be complete until the Student Application is turned in and accepted by Ms. Leik.
 - Grades are based on daily attendance, participation, quizzes, tests, projects and outside event participation.
 - Attendance is a critical skill to develop in Culinary fields. You will not be able to go to the lab if you are tardy/late for any reason on the day of the lab. If you have more than 10 absences, parents will be notified.
 - Students are required to participate in outside events in the community in Culinary I and II. This gives the students a better understanding of the career opportunities and responsibilities of the food industry. An activity release form will be sent home the first week of school for the semester events. Certain outside events will be required attendance for all students. There are also a number of events I will post students can participate in, but are not required. Some of the events are community business partners who offer opportunities to students to work. I do not attend these events with the students.
